TRAIL ADVENTURE

The Bigfoot Adventure Challenge is a fun outdoor experience and NOT a race—please be courteous of other users and take an opportunity to stop and say hi!

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Weather, post-winter trail conditions, and more will impact route conditions. Please check the Adventures page on the website for current route status.

KNOW YOUR ROUTE — CHECK THE BOX

Very important to note that the routes can be completed in a way that works best for you. Our mapping includes a trailhead start, BUT you can start your adventure anywhere along the route—whether that's your home, work location, or your favorite coffee shop. Start your route, intercept our mapped adventure at your best location, substantially complete the route, and check the box on your passport. For your route-finding help, Strava Routes, Trailforks Routes, and Paper Maps can be found at bigfootadventurechallenge.com with instructions for use.

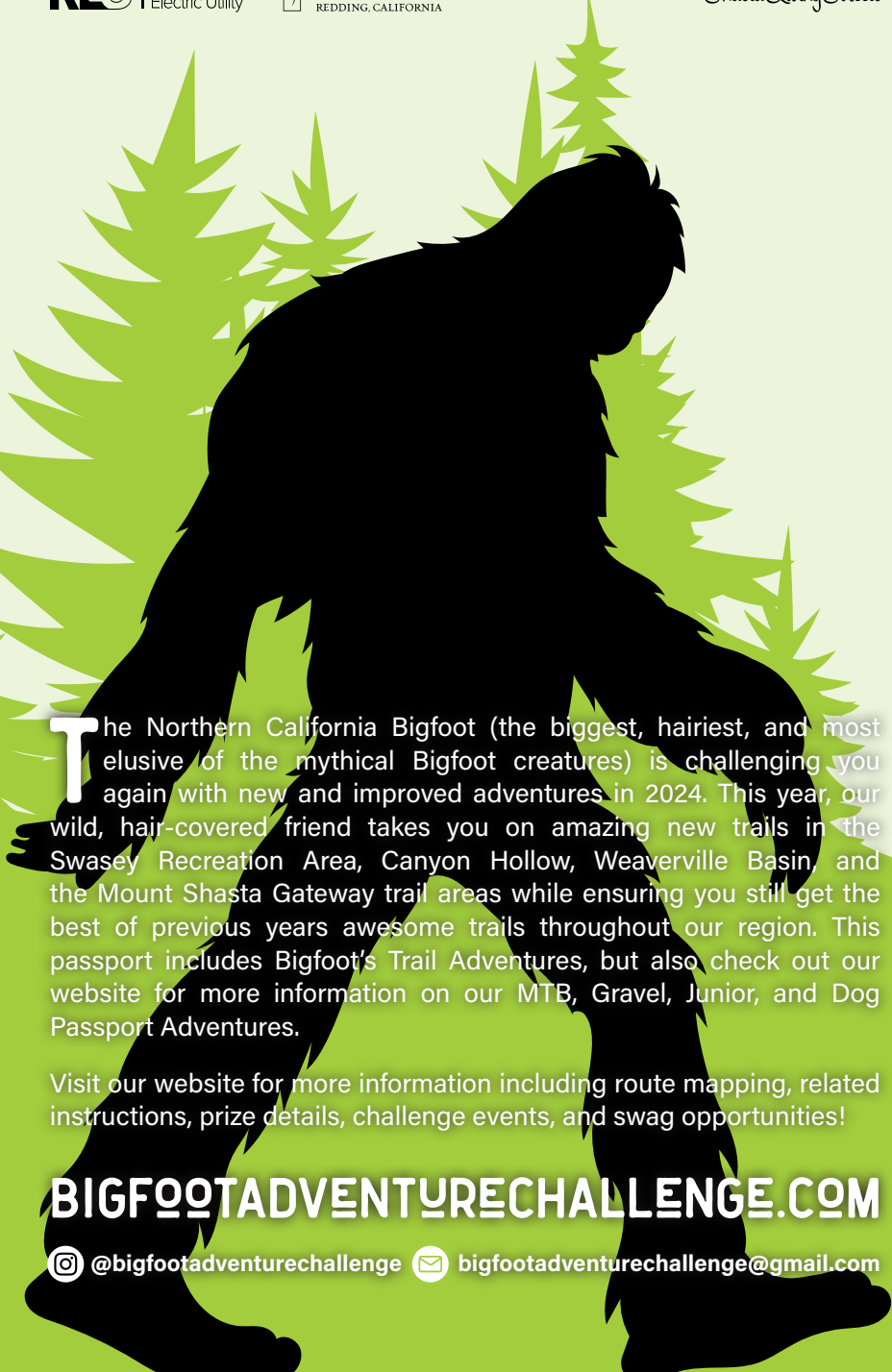
